After opponents opening bid of 1 minor **showing** a natural opening bid
Our overcall of 2 hearts **at** All vulnerability
Shows: Hearts OR spades
Applies: All the time

Detailed Description:

Shows either a weak two (preempt) in hearts OR spades. Normally at least a 6 card suit.

Responses are following the same principles as the responses to Multi 2D

- (1m) – 2H – (p) – p = pass or correct to 2S from overcaller if doubled
- (1m) – 2H – (p) – 2S = pass or correct to 3H, heart support if it is hearts the overcaller has
- (1m) – 2H – (p) – 2NT = Asking: 3C = Max, 3D/3H = Min with H/S
- (1m) – 2H – (p) – 2NT,
- (p) – 3C – (p) – 3D = Asking: 3H = S, 3S = H with no void, 4C/4D/4H = H and void in C/D/S
- (1m) – 2H – (p) – 3C/3D = To play (bid only with support and max)
- (1m) – 2H – (p) – 3H = pass or correct to 3S
- (1m) – 2H – (p) – 4C = Ask the overcaller to bid the suit under his “Weak 2”
- (1m) – 2H – (p) – 3NT/4H/4S = To play (4H/4S with own suit)

Responses and Rebids When Responder Passes

With what hands will advancer pass the overcall?

Most weak hands, expecting the overcaller to correct to 2S (if it is spades) when doubled

Meanings of other advances and follow ups:

(1m) – 2H – (p) – ?, the bidding following the principles of Multi 2D (see over in “Detailed Description”)

Competitive Agreements

Responses after opponent’s DBL (including Pass, RDBL and expected follow-ups)

Pass: Ask the overcaller to pass or correct, RDBL: Asks partner to bid 2S, Others as with no DBL

Responses after opponent’s bid:

3H: Pass or correct to 3S, Others: Natural

Rebids after opener DBLs the overcall (1X)-2Y-(P)-P-(DBL)-?

To correct to 2S with S

Rebids after opener DBLs advancer’s bid:

Proposed Defence

DBL = 10+ hcp, bal., at least 3 hearts

2S = Natural F1

2NT = 11-13 hcp, bal. with 1 stopper

3H = FG with support

Raise in partner’s suit = 8-10 hcp with support
