

DEFENSIVE AND COMPETITIVE BIDDING
OVERCALLS (Style: Responses: 1 / 2 Level; Reopening)
Somewhat aggressive
Transfer responses
INT OVERCALL (2nd/4th Live; Responses; Reopening)
15-18, Stayman and transfers
10-16 balancing seat, size asks
JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)
Preemptive, aggressive
Unusual NT
Reopen: Strong
DIRECT & JUMP CUE BIDS (Style; Response; Reopen)
(1m)-2m = majors. (1M)=2M = other M and a minor
(2M)-3M = Stopper ask
Jump cue in minor natural. In major, stopper ask.
VS. NT (vs. Strong/Weak; Reopening;PH)
Vs. Str: DBL = 4-card major and longer minor, 2♣ = majors, 2♦ = 1 major, 2M = 5M and a minor
Vs. wk: Dbl = penalty, no major, 2♣ = at least 1 4-card major, 2♦ and 2♥ = transfers, 2♠ = minors, 2NT = 4-4-4-1, stiff major
VS. PREEMTS (Doubles; Cue-bids; Jumps; NT Bids)
2NT response to takeout double is relay to 3♣
VS. ARTIFICIAL STRONG OPENINGS- i.e. 1♣ or 2♣
DBL = 2 suits same color. 1♦ = 2 suits same rank. 1NT = 2 suits same shape.
Same vs. 2♣ opener.
OVER OPPONENTS' TAKEOUT DOUBLE
After 1♦-(DBL), xx =shows hearts and transfers.
After 1M-(DBL), 2-level bids up to 2M are transfers.

SYSTEM SUMMARY
GENERAL APPROACH AND STYLE
Precision. Open all 11-counts
1♣ Strong, artificial – Relays if positive response
1♦: 11-15, 2+ diamonds:
1M: 5+ 1/2 2 over 1 GF
1NT: 10-12 nv 1/2 14-16 v 1/2 15-17 3/4
2♣ : 6+ clubs, 10-15
Very aggressive pre-empts
SPECIAL BIDS THAT MAY REQUIRE DEFENSE
2♦: Weak 2 in a major
2♥: Short diamonds, 11-15
2♠: Good diamond preempt
2NT: Both minors, less than opening bid
SPECIAL FORCING PASS SEQUENCES
After we open 1♣ and opponents bid to 4-level, double is usually a forcing pass, and pass is usually a penalty double.
